



# Merrimack Valley Credit Union 2019 Scholarship Award

## Who is eligible for the Merrimack Valley Credit Union Scholarship?

**Eight \$1,000** scholarships and **one \$2,000** scholarship will be awarded to graduating seniors of public, private religious, or technical high schools in the Merrimack Valley. Students who will be attending full time (at least 12 credits or its equivalent) in a certificate, associate's, or bachelor's program at an accredited college located in the United States are eligible to apply. Scholarships will be applied to tuition, fees, or class-related expenses. Applicants do not need to be current members of Merrimack Valley Credit Union.

## When is the deadline?

Interested students must submit their application to Merrimack Valley Credit Union via mail on or before February 28, 2019.

## Application Procedure & Checklist

Complete the application in its entirety. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Along with the application, complete application packages must include:

- Transcript of student grades
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, scout leader, religious leader, etc.
- Completed essay
