Who is eligible for the Scholarship?

Fifteen \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors of public, private religious, or technical high schools in the Merrimack Valley and South Shore regions. Students who will be attending full time (at least 12 credits or its equivalent) in a certificate, associate's, or bachelor's program at an accredited college located in the United States are eligible to apply. Scholarships will be applied to tuition, fees, or class-related expenses. Applicants do not need to be current members of Merrimack Valley Credit Union or Bridgewater Credit Union - though two scholarships will be reserved for members.

When is the deadline?

Interested students must submit their application via mail on or before March 1, 2020.

Application Procedure & Checklist

Complete the application in its entirety. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Along with the application, complete application packages must include:

- Transcript of student grades
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, scout leader, religious leader, etc.
- Completed essay of 500 words or less: "If I ran the credit union, I would..."
